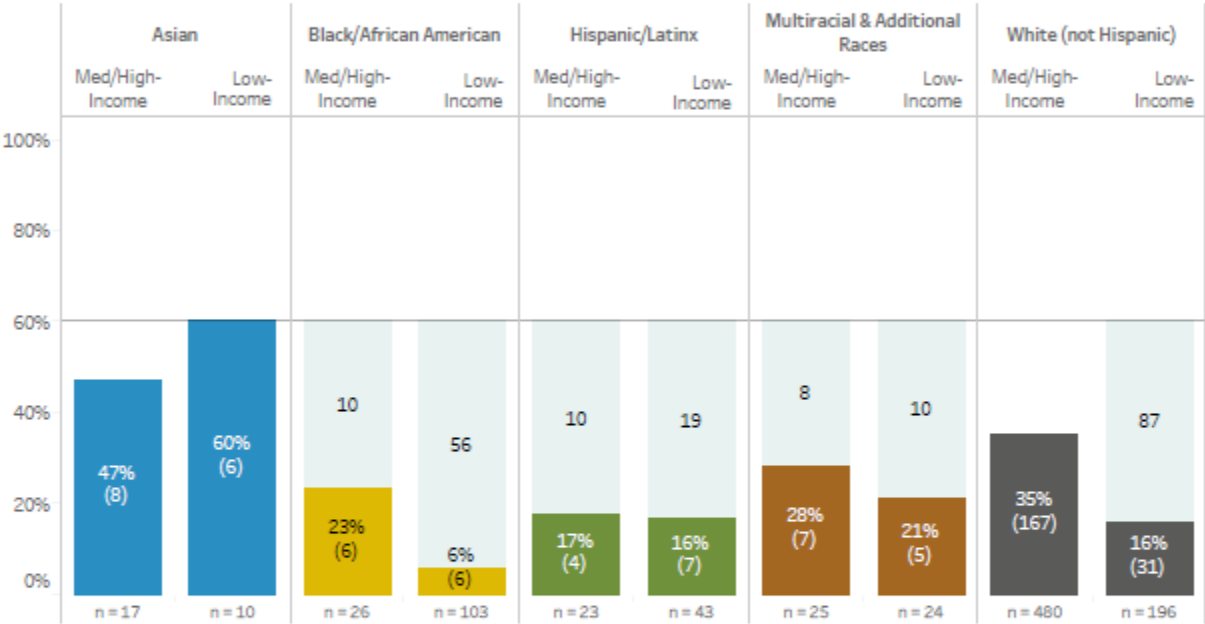




Equity & Access in Sample High School

How to read this chart:

The goal of a school's work with Equal Opportunity Schools (EOS) is to ensure that 11th and 12th grade students are equitably enrolled in AP®, meaning that no matter a student's race or socioeconomic status, they are just as likely as their peers to take an AP® class. We use the Opportunity Chart to set goals for how a AP® program will grow among a target group of students to ensure students who have been historically underrepresented in AP programs across the country have equal access. We will refer to the students we focus on as our "target group"- this includes your population of Latinx, Black, Native American, Pacific Islander, multiracial and low-income students.
